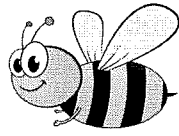

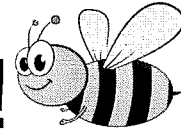

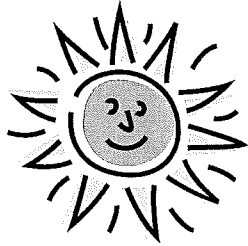

We have some outdoor events coming up. Please make sure that your child is prepared for being in the sun. Here are some ways to keep your child safe.

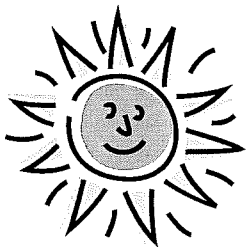


- Wear Sunscreen.
