





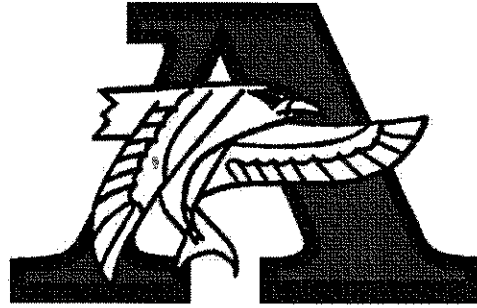
Sonnesyn Weekly Information

What: A parade for all students and families of Armstrong High School and its feeder schools, followed by a tailgate with music and hot dog dinners for sale.

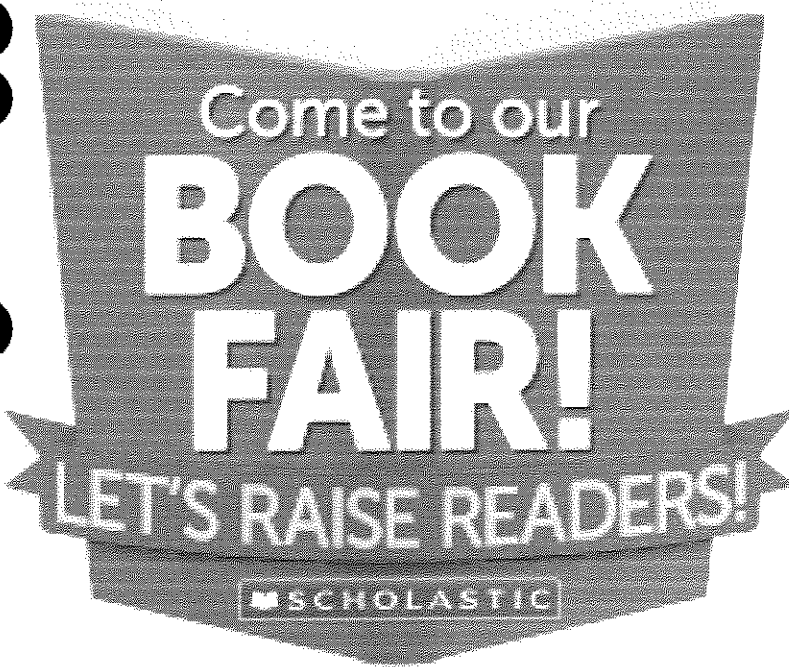
When: **Friday, September 21, at 4:30pm.** We will begin lining up at Armstrong High School around 4:00pm. The tailgate will begin immediately after the parade.

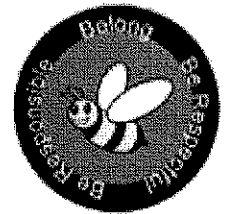

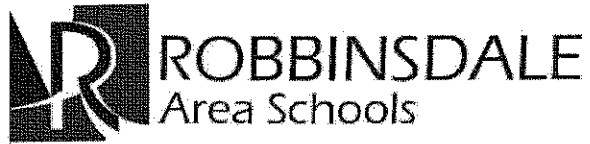
